**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TWENTY-FOUR MONTH TIME EXTENSION FOR

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners authorized the Bow Lake Transfer and Recycling Station Project by passage of Resolution 09-4-15C (attached and incorporated herein by this reference).


**WHEREAS**, the Developer, King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks – Solid Waste Division, did not complete construction within the 18-month period as specified in the developer extension agreement dated April 15, 2009 and on file at the District.


**WHEREAS**, the Developer desires to proceed with the project and requires a time extension of twenty-four months in order to complete the construction.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners of Highline Water District grant King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks – Solid Waste Division, a time extension of 24 months from the date of this resolution to complete the Bow Lake Transfer and Recycling Station Project.


