6. STAFF/COMMISSIONERS/ATTORNEY

Matt informed the Board of the following items from the 5/19/10 GM Report:

- Southcenter Parkway Extension/Tukwila South Project Matt distributed to the Board draft copies of the Tukwila Interlocal Agreement and the Segale Reimbursement Agreement and updated the Board on the current negotiations. Matt explained to the Board that the District and Segale Properties, LLC are in agreement to split the additional design costs of \$46,756, and split the costs for the construction of two PRV stations and the 1,750 lineal feet of water main installation on Orillia Road between S. 200th St. & S. 204th St. Matt asked the Board for authorization to draft an agreement to include splitting the additional design costs and construction costs for the PRV stations and the water main on Orillia Road. The Board authorized Matt's request.
- KCWD 49 and HWD Intertie The intertie will go before the Seattle Operating Board for approval and recording of the intertie.
- Demand Metering SPU suspended demand metering for 2010.
- <u>Des Moines Water Issues</u> Matt distributed to the Board and staff an article from the Highline Times entitled "Water Woes Stop D.M. Growth."
- Matt commented on an email from Tom Griffith (SPU) thanking Dave Stanley for his hard work in preparing and coordinating the tapping team competition and emceeing the Meter Madness event at the PNWS-AWWA Conference in Tacoma on May 12-13, 2010.
- <u>HWD Tapping Team</u> The District's tapping team qualified to go to the national competition in Chicago with a third place finish at the Pacific Northwest Section-AWWA Competition, however, Matt said the District would not send the team to the ACE 2010 Conference due to the poor current economical climate.

- ♦ 490 Zone Additional Water Main Replacement @ S. 223rd St. from 19th Ave S to 24th Ave S Jeremy informed the Board that the City of Des Moines did not receive grant funding for proposed street improvements; therefore, there is no urgency or necessity for the District to move forward at this time. Jeremy requested a motion from the Board to rescind the authorization for this work (See Section 5 Resolutions/Motions).
- Des Moines North Twin Bridge Project Bid Opening C.A. Carey Construction was the low bidder. The bid amount was approximately 23% below the engineer's estimate.
- Project 07-2 McMicken Heights Well & Treatment Plant The Notice of Proposed Land Use Action for the Rezone/Conditional Use Permit was advertised by the City of SeaTac. The comment deadline is 6/1/10; the appeal deadline is 6/11/10; and the hearing date is scheduled for 6/17/10. Jeremy will update the Board at the 6/22/10 Workshop meeting.
- ♦ Star Lake East DE @ 46th Ave S & S 279th St The developer (Washington Federal Savings Bank) asked the District to provide an estimate for District crews to stub water main into the plat prior to King County doing street improvements in front of the property. Jeremy said staff would bring a resolution to the Board at a future meeting.

There being no further business of the District, President Quong-Vermeire concluded the meeting at 4:46 PM.
