1. CALL TO ORDER

<u>Project 08-1 Salt Air Hills Water Main Replacement Update</u> – All water main will be installed by the end of next week. Jeremy informed the Board that the existing roadway is not withstanding the construction activities and is failing in numerous areas. HWD, along with Midway Sewer District, evaluated several alternatives with the City of Kent and recommend pulverizing the entire road and reconstructing the surface with 3" asphalt overlay. The 3" overlay will eliminate the trench patching but it will increase the asphalt quantity by approximately 3,000 tons for an additional cost to the District of approximately \$125,000. A resolution for a contract revision will go before the Board at a future Board meeting when the exact quantities are determined.
