- 6.1 <u>2013/2014 Remote Sites Landscape Maintenance</u> Staff sent request for proposals to contractors on the MRSC Small Works Roster. The proposals are due on 2/28/13. A resolution to award the contract will be presented at the 3/6/13 Board meeting.
- 6.2 <u>2013/2014 HWD Headquarters Landscape Maintenance</u> Staff is working on the scope of work and will request proposals from contractors on the MRSC Small Works Roster on 3/5/13.
- 6.3 <u>Project 13-1 Angle Lake Water Main Replacement</u> An open house for the area residents will be held at the Tyee High School cafeteria at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, February 26th. At 7:00 pm, BHC Consultants will give a presentation on the proposed water main alignment and answer questions about the project.

6.4 Project 11-3 City of Des Moines Gateway Project

Segment 1 - 24th Ave S: The District's portion includes the replacement of approximately 2,450 LF of 12" AC water main along 24th Ave S from S 216th St to S 208th St. The District's construction documents will need to be completed by April 2013.

Segment 2 - S 216th St: SCI Construction was awarded contract. The District's portion includes replacement of approximately 750 LF of 12" and small AC water mains at the intersection of 24th Ave S and 20th Ave S along S 216th St. The water main work is scheduled for May 2013.

6.5 <u>King County 5th Annual Investment Pool Meeting 1/24/13</u>

Debbie attended the meeting and commented on the following items discussed: (1) 4th Quarter 2012 Investment Review – The portfolio continues to possess high credit quality and a high level of liquidity; (2) Impaired Investments – Cheyne litigation trial is scheduled for May 2013; (3) Economic Outlook for 2013 – Slow growth, however, King County overall is faring better than the nation.

6.6 <u>Public Records Request from Daryl Tapio, Olympic Development</u> – Matt requested clarification from Mr. Tapio's request for all emails sent and received including attachments (1/1/1995 – 2/1/13) from the General Manager. The Board was shown Mr. Tapio's email response dated

2/11/13. The District's legal counsel is reviewing the General Manager's emails to comply with Chapter 42.56. RCW – Public Records Act, Section 42.56.070 - Documents and indexes to be made public. The District has determined that there are over 13,000 potentially responsive records to the request. Matt will keep the Board updated on the cost and labor associated with this public records request.

- 6.7 <u>2/5/13 Emergency Repair @ 17415 2nd Ave SW</u> The main was shut down and five houses were out of service. A full vertical crack was found in the 6" CI main at the footing of a retaining wall. The main was repaired with a stainless steel band and restoration completed. The estimated water loss was 15,000 gallons.
- 6.8 <u>Seattle Water Supply Operating Board</u> Matt was elected Chair for 2013.
