- 6.2 <u>State Audit</u> The District's audit is going well and the auditor expects to complete the audit by the end of the week. The exit conference will be held sometime in November.

- 6.4 <u>2014 Water Rate Adjustment</u> Matt informed the Board that he is proposing an approximate 2.4% rate increase. The proposed rate increase will be discussed in further detail at the 10/22/13 Board Workshop meeting.
- 6.5 <u>HWD Water Supply vs. Water Sales (Jan Sept 2013)</u> Water sales were at 2,094,683 CCFs, a slight increase from 2012. The unaccounted-for water loss was approximately 6%, better than the past few years.
