**RESOLUTION AMENDING HIGHLINE WATER DISTRICT CODE (HWDC), TITLE 6 WATER SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES, CHAPTER 6.04 RATES, SECTION 6.04.060 – GENERAL FACILITY CHARGE (GFC) DEFINED, ITEM 3 - RESIDENTIAL FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEMS**

**WHEREAS**, District management and staff determined that the Residential Fire Sprinkler Systems policy of the District needed to be updated to be in accordance with the current Uniform Plumbing Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed revisions to HWDC Title 6 Water Service Rates and Charges, Chapter 6.04 Rates, Section 6.04.060 General Facility Fire Sprinkler Systems – Item 3 are as follows:

**6.04.060 GENERAL FACILITY CHARGE (GFC) DEFINED**

**3. Residential Fire Sprinkler Systems:**

~~In jurisdictions where an~~ Where a 1" meter is requested to accommodate an automatic fire sprinkler ~~is required~~ for a one-family dwelling, the GFC for a 1" meter will be based on one ERU Unit, if the increase in meter size from ¾" to 1" is required solely to accommodate the automatic fire sprinkler. The Applicant shall provide documentation that a ¾" meter is ~~sufficient~~ adequate based on the plumbing fixture count, in accordance with ~~Tables 6-5 and 6-6~~ of the Uniform Plumbing Code. *(Effective ~~12/1/10~~ 2/19/14 per Resolution ~~10-11-3D~~ 14-2-19A).*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

The Board of Commissioners authorizes the General Manager to amend *HWDC Title 6 Water Service Rates and Charges, Chapter 6.04 Rates, Section 6.04.060 General Facility Charge (GFC) Defined, Item 3 – Residential Fire Sprinkler Systems*, as referenced in this document and incorporated herein.
