6.4 <u>Washington State Legislature HB 1133 – 2015-16</u> - Kathleen informed the Board about proposed House Bill 1133 which would: • Authorize counties to impose a tax on utilities providing service to consumers within the county; • Establish a maximum tax rate of 6 percent; • Authorize counties to provide certain exemptions from the tax; • Obligate counties imposing a utility tax to provide a credit against utility taxes imposed by cities or towns.

A public hearing in the House Committee was held on 1/22/15.
