Resolution <u>15-5-20C</u> accepting Project 11-3 Segment 1 24th Ave S (D.P.K., Inc. – Contractor / City of Des Moines Lead Agency). Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion <u>15-5-20(1)</u> authorizing payment of \$1,000.00 to King County Special Purpose Districts Growth Management Planning Council (GMPC) for participation of the 2015-2016 staffing services. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

- 6.1 <u>Tyee Well Redevelopment</u> The District will request proposals on 5/21/15 from five firms for the redevelopment of the Tyee Well. The firms were selected from the Municipal Research Services Center (MRSC) Small Works Roster. The bid due date is June 4, 2015.
- 6.2 <u>Sound Transit Federal Way Link Extension</u> Jeremy discussed proposed alignments with the Board. The comment period on Sound Transit's Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is April 10 May 26, 2015.

- 6.3 <u>Surplus Vehicles</u> The District's two 2007 Chevy Colorado trucks and the 1999 International 4900 dump truck were sold at the Washington State Enterprise Auction. The District netted \$48,800.

- 6.5 <u>GMPC Funding for Consulting Services</u> Matt polled the Board to determine if they were interested in the District contributing financially for staffing of the Growth Management Planning Council (GMPC). The Board was in agreement to contribute \$1,000.00. Action Taken: Reference Motion 15-5-20(1).
- 6.6 <u>District Headquarters Building Exterior Maintenance</u> Matt, Jeremy, Debbie and Al Metz met yesterday with Galen Page, Page & Beard Architects, to discuss the following maintenance items: (1) options to prevent birds from infiltrating the building's Styrofoam façade; (2) adding flashing to the lip of the gutters to prevent damage and overflow; (3) repairing the leak at the southwest corner of the Board room; and (4) exterior painting.
