RESOLUTION 15-6-17B

**RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT #15-70-06 TO HOKKAIDO DRILLING, INC.
FOR THE TYEE WELL REDEVELOPMENT (PROJECT 15-1)**

WHEREAS, the well was designed for an instantaneous withdrawal rate of 750 gpm and an annual production of 600 acre-feet per year, however, there has been a gradual decline in instantaneous production over time; and

WHEREAS, the District's consultant, Robinson Noble, prepared a scope of work to accomplish redevelopment of the Tyee Well to address the progressive declines in well efficiency; and

WHEREAS, the District requested proposals on 5/21/15 from five firms for the redevelopment of the well. The firms were selected from the Municipal Research Services Center (MRSC) Small Works Roster; and

WHEREAS, Hokkaido Drilling, Inc. was the sole bidder and the General Manager and District Engineer have reviewed the bid (referenced as Exhibit A and incorporated herein) and deem the bid responsive and recommend approval of this resolution.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:



3. COMPLETION DATE

Bidder proposes and agrees, if awarded the Agreement, to complete all requirements of the work in the Agreement in accordance with the following schedules. Time limits are in calendar days after Notice to Proceed.

Total Project - Final Completion – 45 calendar days.

Bidder accepts the provisions of the Agreement as to liquidated damages in the event of failure to complete the work on time.

4. The Bidder acknowledges that all work shown on the contract documents are not specifically covered as individual Bid Items. The Bidder acknowledges that such work including all labor, materials and equipment shall be considered incidental to the project and have been included within the bid prices.
