6. WSDOT SR 509 EXPANSION & SOUND TRANSIT FEDERAL WAY LIGHT RAIL EXPANSION Jeremy DelMar

<u>Sound Transit Federal Way Light Rail Expansion</u> - Jeremy distributed documents from Sound Transit's website outlining the route alternatives and proposed station locations. The Sound Transit Board prefers the I-5 alignment.

Sound Transit and the District will meet in September to discuss impacts to District infrastructure based on selected alignment. Discussion ensued. No action taken.

<u>WSDOT SR 509/SR 167 Expansion</u> – Jeremy distributed documents from WSDOT's website outlining the proposed 509 projects. Discussion ensued. No action taken.

7.1 State Audit – The audit is underway.

- 7.2 <u>Commissioner Position 1 Vacancy</u> –The District has received three letters of interest. The deadline for submission is 8/21/15. The interview process will be discussed at the 8/25/15 Board Workshop.
- 7.3 <u>Water Shortage Contingency Plan Update</u> The City of Seattle has implemented the advisory stage asking customers to use 10% less water. There is a potential for a mandatory stage if the hot, dry weather continues in September.
- 7.4 <u>Enduris (Insurance Pool)</u> The District's premium was increased by approximately 2%. The liability coverage was doubled.
- 7.5 <u>Enduris Anti-Harrassment Training</u> The District will host three 2-1/2 hour training sessions on September 1, 2015.
- 7.6 Headquarters Exterior Painting District crews are painting the exterior of the building.
