# 7. STAFF/COMMISSIONERS/ATTORNEY Jeremy DelMar

- 7.1 <u>Sound Transit Federal Way Link Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)</u> A resolution to authorize a memorandum of understanding with Sound Transit will be presented at a future Board meeting.
- 7.2 <u>Tyee Well Rehabilitation Status</u> Jeremy updated the Board on the status of the rehabilitation. The District continues to explore the possibility of surface water infiltration into the well and will perform subsequent testing. Discussion ensued. A change order for Hokkaido Drilling to reinstall the surface seal will be presented at a future Board meeting.
- 7.3 <u>FCSG Draft Rates Model</u> Jeremy discussed preliminary results of the FCSG model for fire allocation and General Facility Charges (GFCs). Discussion ensued. Staff will discuss further at the January 26 Board Workshop.

- 7.4 WASWD 1/30/16 Commissioners' Workshop (Tukwila, WA) Matt reminded the Commissioners of the Workshop. District staff will register Commissioners' Fultz, Johnson and Quong-Vermeire.
- 7.5 <u>Enduris Request</u> Matt informed the Board that an attorney for Enduris asked him to be an expert witness regarding a ladder failure inside a vault. The Board was in agreement to support Matt's decision to participate or not.
- 7.6 City of Des Moines Proposed Utility Tax Ordinance Southwest Suburban Sewer District, Midway Sewer District, Highline Water District and King County Water District No. 54 have all signed a joint payment agreement and joint prosecution agreement with Talmadge/Fitzpatrick/Tribe. Phil Talmadge, Legal Counsel, will prepare a draft complaint against the City's proposed utility tax. The four districts will meet to discuss a potential draft franchise agreement with the City of Des Moines.
