- 6.1 <u>Errors & Omissions Indemnity Policy</u> Matt informed the Board that a resolution will be presented at the 3/28/17 Workshop to establish a policy providing for the indemnification and defense of District Commissioners and Employees.
- 6.2 <u>Auto Damage Claim (S 252nd St & 30th Ave S)</u> The District received a Notice of Small Claim from King County District Court in Burien. The plaintiff (Sequyoiah Gordon) alleges a manhole cover popped up and caused damage underneath rental car.
