#### 4. EXECUTIVE SESSION – PENDING LITIGATION RE: CITY OF FEDERAL WAY EXCISE TAX

Resolution <u>18-5-16D</u> authorizing Release of Right of Entry - YMCA of Greater Seattle (King County Recording No. 20110819000328). Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Resolution <u>18-5-16E</u> authorizing Release of Easement - YMCA of Greater Seattle (King County Recording No. 20091221000519). Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Resolution <u>18-5-16F</u> authorizing granting an easement to the City of Des Moines (HWD Pump Station No. 5 Site). Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion <u>18-5-16(1)</u> duly made and seconded directing staff to prepare and present a letter at the 5/22/18 Board Workshop on behalf of the Board of Commissioners, indicating the Board's intent to extend the General Manager's Employment Agreement beyond the current end date of December 31, 2018.
