**RESOLUTION 19-2-6B**

**RESOLUTION AMENDING HIGHLINE WATER DISTRICT CODE (HWDC) CHAPTER 6.04 RATES, SECTION 6.04.020, TABLE 3, WATER SERVICE INSTALLATION CHARGES, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZES STAFF TO MAKE ANNUAL ADJUSTMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 6.04.020 Table 3 of the HWDC identifies the District's Water Service Installation Charges; and

**WHEREAS**, water service installation charges can change over time and must be modified to recover the District's direct and indirect expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, the District desires to revise the fees accordingly to be at the current market rates; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed revisions to Highline Water District Code, Section 6.04.020 Water/Miscellaneous Rates are as follows:

<b>Request for Water Service Installation</b>		
The District will install/modify existing water services/mains and/or fire hydrants as requested by Agreement (reference Water Service Installation Agreement REF #409). The requesting party shall pay for all costs associated with installation/modification of the water service. The District will prepare a cost estimate for the work and require a deposit in the full amount prior to executing the Agreement. If the deposit is in excess of the actual costs, the difference will be refunded. If the actual cost of the work exceeds the estimate, the difference will be owed to the District (per Res. 13-5-1B, effective 5/1/13).


