- 6.1 <u>Project 19-3 KDM/PHS & 9th Pl S Water Main Replacement</u> Staff plans to advertise the project in late March.
- 6.2 Tyee Well Pump The pump is scheduled to be pulled on March 18-19 by PumpTech, Inc. Shannon & Wilson will follow with a video assessment of the pump.
- 6.3 <u>Pump Station 2</u> The original horizontal split-case VFD controlled pump for the Des Moines Treatment Plant is failing. The estimated cost is between \$15,000 -\$20,000. A resolution to authorize a contract with PumpTech, Inc. will be presented to the Board at the 3/20/19 meeting.
- 6.4 <u>2018 Water Consumption</u> The District purchased/produced approximately 2.5 billion gallon of water in 2018. This is about three times the volume of water in Angle Lake.
