6.2 <u>Delinquent Account Payment Plan</u> - The latest proclamation of the Governor extended through 7/28/20 that no water service shut offs would be allowed and no late charges could be assessed due to COVID-19 pandemic. If the 7/28/20 deadline is not extended, the District's regular policy will be enforced if payment arrangements that are made during the Governor's restriction on service interruptions are not kept. The current delinquent bills (60 days or older) are at 14% (approximately \$110,000). Matt will update the Commissioners at the 7/15/20 Board meeting.
