### 6. OTHER

#### **Matt Everett**

- 6.1 <u>Federal Way Excise Tax Lawsuit</u> The Federal Way excise tax of 7.75% on gross revenue was enacted in March 2018. Highline, Midway Sewer and Lakehaven challenged the tax and appealed to the Washington State Supreme Court for direct review. The 8 to 1 ruling on 6/18/20 went in favor of the City of Federal Way which will allow cities to impose an unlimited tax on the revenues received from water-sewer ratepayers or other proprietary functions in which the Districts engage within the City's limits.
- 6.2 <u>WASWD Summer Managers Meeting (6/23/20 @ 9:30 am)</u> Matt will participate at today's meeting remotely.
- 6.3 <u>WASWD Fall and Spring Conferences</u> President Koester suggested the General Manager prepare a letter to Judi Gladstone, WASWD Executive Director, stating the District's position for WASWD to continue holding Fall and Spring in-person conferences. The Board unanimously voted to direct the General Manager to write the letter.

6.4 Engineering/Standards Guide for Developer Extensions - Jeremy suggested that in lieu of the Board authorizing a developer extension agreement, he would like to provide a summary of active and pending developer extensions to be included in the Managers' Report and make entering into a developer extension agreement an administrative function of staff. The Board was in favor of eliminating resolutions to authorize developer extension agreements. Jeremy is finalizing an Engineering/Standards Guide for Developer Extensions and will present a resolution in July for the Board's consideration to adopt.
