- 6.5 <u>Remote Meetings</u> The Board of Commissioners reviewed a letter by President Vince Koester to Governor Inslee requesting that in-person public meetings resume as of 11/10/20. There were no objections to sending the letter.
- 6.6 <u>Burien Utility Tax</u> A proposed 8% utility tax on water and sewer districts on all gross revenue will be on the agenda for consideration at the City Council Regular Meeting on November 2, 2020.
- 6.7 WASWD Managers Meeting 10/13/20 One item discussed was the CARES Act which provides for payments to State and Local governments dealing with the impact of the COVID-19 outbreak. The Customer Service Supervisor will call the seven cities in the District's service area to determine if they have funds available for ratepayers having difficulty paying their water bills due to COVID-19.
