6.2 <u>Vulnerability Assessment</u> – Staff is reviewing the completed Vulnerability Assessment prepared by Carollo Engineers in compliance with the America's Water Infrastructure Act (AWIA). The District must now update its Emergency Response Plan by June 30, 2021. A resolution to authorize a contract amendment with Carollo Engineers to assist the District with the update will be presented at a future Board meeting.

6.7 Emergency Funding Cares Act – Commissioner Daigle asked Matt if the District participated in the Cares Act to help customers in need. Matt stated that the funding was tied to federal regulations and did not include Districts in the appropriation. The District has referred customers to the City where they reside as they have been appropriated the funds. The District pushed out late charges on past due accounts to the end of April 2021 to assist customers and meet the Washington State Governor's proclamations.
