- 6.2 <u>Executive Session</u> The District will hold an executive session at the 5/25/21 Board Workshop to discuss the draft Federal Way Franchise Agreement.
- 6.3 <u>Employee Update</u> The District's current Construction Observer resigned to pursue other opportunities. The District will replace the personnel with a Senior Utility Worker who has been cross training in the position for the last year. Two other employees will begin crosstraining in construction observation. The District will advertise for a utility worker position next week.
- 6.4 <u>16-2 George Landon Pump Station No. 8</u> Resolution <u>18-8-28A</u> authorized Puget Sound Energy (PSE) to provide power to the site. PSE has recalculated the costs and it has been determined the station demands require additional electrical equipment. The original contract was \$32,557.59. Jeremy requested a motion for the Board to authorize an amendment to the contract for the necessary electrical upgrades to increase the authorized amount by \$40,000 to a new total of \$72,557.59.
