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# 6. STAFF/COMMISSIONERS/ATTORNEY Phil Hite

- 6.1 <u>SCADA WIN911/WINCC System Software</u>: Operations Manager Hite informed the Board that a portion of the SCADA system software will no longer be supported at the end of the year and will require upgrade. The purchase price for the replacement software and supporting software should be within the purchasing authority of staff.
- 6.2 Pump Station 6 SCADA System Upgrades: Hite informed the Board that Pump Station 6 system controls need upgrades. The existing hardware will soon not be able to support software version upgrades. Lead time for the replacement equipment may exceed 74 weeks. Discussion ensued. Hite stated he will bring back to the Board a Resolution to authorize the single source and proceed with the ordering of the equipment.
- 6.3 <u>Staffing</u> Hite informed the Board that we have made an offer to a candidate to fill the Utility Worker position.

#### **Anne Paige**

- 6.4 <u>Year End Financials:</u> Admin Manager Paige informed the Board that the year-end financials have been submitted to the Washington State Auditor's Office.
- 6.5 <u>Enterprise Resource Program (ERP) System:</u> Paige updated the status of the project to the Board. No action taken.

#### Jeremy DelMar

- 6.6 Des Moines Treatment Plant Electrical Upgrades: General Manager DelMar updated the Board on the need to upgrade power equipment at the DMTP. He discussed the proposal from RH2 Engineering for preliminary work to identify needed work and proposed costs. Discussion ensued. Under existing approval authority, DelMar will enter into an agreement for the first phase of work with RH2.
- 6.7 <u>Project Bids</u>: DelMar informed the Board that two District projects will be out to bid by partner agencies in June. The projects include the City of Des Moines 24<sup>th</sup> Ave S project and the King County Trail relocation project.
