The District partnered with the Washington State Department of Transportation as part of the SR509 Project to relocate and replace water system appurtenances in conflict. The District relocated existing water mains within the parcels and no longer needs the easements.

The Grantee, its successors, or assigns, further agrees to defend the Grantor, its agents, or employees in any litigation, including payment of any judgments, costs or attorney's fees, for any claims or action commenced arising out of or in connection with acts or activities related to this Easement. This obligation shall not include such claims, costs, damages (both to persons and/or property), or expenses which may be caused by the sole negligence of the Grantor, or its agents, and/or employees; provided that, if the claims or damages are caused by or result from the concurrent negligence of (a) the Grantor, its agents, or employees and (b) the Grantee, its agents, contractors, licensees, invitees, employees, and/or any other person, or involves those actions covered by RCW 4.24.115, this indemnity provision shall be valid and enforceable only to the extent of the negligence of the Grantee or Grantee's agents, contractors, licensees, invitees, employees, and/or any other person.

The Grantee, on behalf of itself and its successors, or assigns, as part consideration herein, do hereby agree to comply with all civil rights and anti-discrimination requirements of chapter 49.60 RCW as to the lands herein conveyed.




