RESOLUTION 21-11-17A

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE *KENT REPORTER* AND THE *SEATTLE DAILY JOURNAL OF COMMERCE* AS THE DISTRICT'S OFFICIAL NEWSPAPERS FOR THE PUBLICATION OF LEGAL NOTICES

WHEREAS, by passage of Resolution 04-10-6E, the District identified the *Highline Times/Des Moines News* and the *Seattle Daily Journal of Commerce* as the District's official newspapers for the publication of legal notices; and

WHEREAS, the *Westside Seattle*, formerly the *Highline Times/Des Moines News*, published its final print issue on April 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, to communicate with the local community, the District must identify a replacement newspaper and desires to designate the *Kent Reporter* as the District's official newspaper regarding public notices of the Board of Commissioners meetings and office schedule; and


WHEREAS, for legal notices regarding sale of property, requests for proposals from outside consultants/contractors and bid advertisements for construction projects, the District designates the *Seattle Daily Journal of Commerce* to remain its newspaper of record.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Board of Commissioners designates the *Kent Reporter* as the official newspaper of record for public notices of all meetings and office schedule changes.
2. The Board of Commissioners designates the *Seattle Daily Journal of Commerce* as the official newspaper of record for ads for the sale of property, equipment and vehicles, requests for proposals from outside consultants, bid ads for contractors, and any other contractor/consultant ads.


