RESOLUTION 23-9-6E

**RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR PROJECT 21-3 MANSION HILL 2.5 MG
RESERVOIR IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

WHEREAS, by passage of Resolution 22-12-21D, the Board of Commissioners authorized the 2023 Capital Improvement Program that included Project 21-3 Mansion Hill 2.5MG Reservoir Improvement Project; and,

WHEREAS, the District advertised Project 21-3 for bids in the Seattle Daily Journal of Commerce on 7/25/23 and 8/1/23. The bid opening was held at the District Headquarters on 8/15/23 at 10:00 am. The District received three (3) bids; and,

WHEREAS, during evaluation of the bidders, the District learned of inconsistencies in the supplemental bidder criteria and the project specifications which have the potential for impacting the evaluation of the lowest responsible bidder; and,

WHEREAS, RCW 57.08.050 authorizes the Board of Commissioners to reject all bids for good cause and readvertise; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to reject all bids and readvertise at a future date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Board of Commissioners rejects all bids for good cause and authorizes the readvertisement for Project 21-3.
2. District staff is directed to incorporate the Project into development of the 2024 Capital Improvement Program.
